**SECTION A : Flower Classes**

**Boyles Cup for the most points in Classes 1 - 25**

**Prince Cup for Best Entry in Classes 1 - 13**

*For definitions of daffodils & narcissi see below right*

**TRUMPET DAFFODILS**

- 1 Vase of trumpet daffodils - one variety, entirely yellow - 3 stems
- 2 Vase of trumpet daffodils - one variety, white petals, any coloured trumpet - 3 stems
- 3 Vase of trumpet daffodils – more than one variety, any colour - 6 stems

**LARGE CUP NARCISSI**

- 4 Vase of large cup narcissi - one variety, entirely yellow - 3 stems
- 5 Vase of large cup narcissi - one variety, white or yellow petals, red or orange cup - 3 stems
- 6 Vase of large cup narcissi - more than one variety, any colour – 6 stems

**SMALL CUP NARCISSI**

- 7 Vase of small cup narcissi - any colour petal, red/orange cup - 3 stems
- 8 Vase of small cup narcissi, more than one variety, any colour – 6 stems

**ANY DAFFODILS/NARCISSI**

- 9 Vase of any daffodils or narcissi - 3 varieties, 2 each = 6 stems

**OTHER DAFFODILS/NARCISSI**

- 10 Vase of double daffodils - 3 stems
- 11 Vase of multiheaded narcissi - more than one bloom per stem- 3 stems
- 12 Vase of miniature daffodils - species narcissi - 3 stems
- 13 Vase of cyclamineus narcissi, any colour - 3 stems

**Sherlock Shield for Best Entry in Classes 14 - 25**

- 14 Vase of tulips - red - 3 stems
- 15 Vase of tulips – one colour other than red - 3 stems
- 16 Vase of tulips – assorted - 6 stems
- 17 Vase of wallflowers - assorted - 6 stems
- 18 Vase of polyanthus - assorted, 5 stems
- 19 Vase of **fragrant** shrub flowers – 3 stems, one or more varieties
- 20 Vase of spring flowers (not shrubs) - 6 stems - one or more varieties not included in cl. 14-18
- 21 Vase of spring or shrub flowers - 6 stems with at least 3 varieties not included in cl. 14-18
- 22 One houseplant - maximum diameter of bowl - 10 inches (25.5 cm)
- 23 Bowl of pansies
- 24 A pot grown orchid
- 25 A cactus

**SECTION B - Domestic Classes**

**Stevens Trophy for the most points in Classes 26 – 31**

*Note: Cover cookery exhibits with film*

- 26 Honey fruit cake (recipe on page ?)
- 27 Apple cake with crunchy topping (recipe on page ?)
- 28 4 of your tastiest savoury scones
- 29 6 cheese cocktail sable biscuits (recipe on page ?)
- 30 Jar of marmalade
- 31 Jar of chutney

**SECTION C - Junior Classes**

**Senior (age 7-10) and Junior (age under 7) Tighe & Hawtin Cups for the most points in cl 32 – 35**

- 32 A decorated egg or eggs
- 33 3 ginger bread persons or shapes
- 34 A painting/drawing of a treehouse
- 35 An original (not Lego) model of a space rocket or space station

**SECTION D - Photographic Classes**

**Parker Trophies classes 36 - 41, most points and best entry.**

- 36 Bicycles
- 37 Mechanisms or locks
- 38 Trees in Winter
- 39 The colour yellow
- 40 Windows
- 41 Technology

**All photographic exhibits to be unmounted, not more than 5" x 8" (13 cm x 20.5 cm)**

**DAFFODILS AND NARCISSI**



*Trumpet daffodils - cup must be at least as long or longer than the outer petals*



*Large cup narcissi – cup must be MORE than 1/3 but LESS than the length of the outer petals*



*Small cup narcissi - cup must NOT be more than 1/3 length of the outer petals*



*Cyclamineus – petals must be swept back*
