Jack Wickson Memorial Cup for the best entry in Class 1

Street Trophy for the best entry in Classes 2 and 3

Drury Memorial Shield for the most points in Classes 5, 6, 13, 14 & 34 (root vegetables)

Harry Charlton Cup for the most points in Classes 1 to 35

Stalks to be left on all beans and fruit

- 1 Selection of 6 mixed vegetables: max width allowed 18 ins.
- 2 5 Tomatoes - Standard (2 ½" maximum)
- 3 5 Tomatoes - Small (1 ½" maximum)
- 4 2 Beef Tomatoes
- 5 3 Potatoes - white
- 6 3 Potatoes - coloured
- 7 3 Onions - set grown, trimmed
- 8 3 Onions - spring sown - trimmed
- 9 3 Onions suitable for kitchen not to exceed 3" dia, untrimmed
- 10 6 Shallots
- 11 2 Cabbages
- 12 3 Carrots - less tops
- 13 3 Beetroot - globe
- 14 2 Lettuce - cabbage or cos type
- 15 3 Leeks
- 16 6 Runner Beans - with stalks
- 17 6 French Beans - with stalks
- 18 2 Sweetcorn
- 19 3 Courgettes
- 20 2 Green Peppers or 2 Red Peppers
- 21 2 Cucumbers
- 22 2 Aubergines
- 23 1 Squash – not Marrow or Courgette
- 24 6 leaves of Spinach, including Spinach Beet
- 25 A bunch of herbs - 5 varieties to be displayed in a glass jar
- 26 1 funniest shaped vegetable
- 27 1 longest Runner Bean
- 28 Selection of 6 mixed fruits: max width allowed 18 ins.
- 29 3 Cooking Apples - one variety
- 30 3 Dessert Apples - one variety
- 31 3 Pears - one variety
- 32 5 Plums - one variety
- 33 9 soft fruits in a bowl - one variety
- 34 Heaviest crop of Potatoes - grown in a 3-gallon (14 litre) bucket from 1 tuber; competitor's own choice of compost. Bring to Show in the bucket with tops taken off by 10.30am
- 35 Best bucket of home-made compost, pre-sieving allowed but avoid adding other ingredients like grit. Bring to the show by 10.30am

SECTION B

Parker Rose Bowl for the best exhibit in class 44

A L Webb Memorial Tray for most points in classes 36 to 49

- 36 Fuchsia – 3 sprays of one or more varieties
- 37 Foliage – 5 stems
- 38 Michaelmas daisies - 3 spikes
- 39 Gladiolus - 1 spike
- 40 Large Dahlia over 8" (200mm) dia - 1 bloom
- 41 Decorative Dahlia less than 8" (200mm) dia - 3 blooms
- 42 Cactus/semi-cactus Dahlia less than 8" (200mm) dia. - 3 blooms
- 43 Any other Dahlia not included in classes 40-42 – 3 blooms
- 44 1 large flowered Rose, single bloom
- 45 3 large flowered Roses, single bloom
- 46 3 stems of cluster flowered Roses, one or more varieties
- 47 Chrysanthemums - 3 blooms - outdoor grown
- 48 Vase with 3 grasses – one or more varieties
- 49 Vase with 5 stems of any other flower or flowers not included above

SECTION C - DOMESTIC CLASSES

Rose Bowl for the most points in classes 50 to 54

Cover cookery exhibits with film

- 50 Date & Chocolate loaf cake – recipe page ?
- 51 Coffee & Walnut cake – own recipe
- 52 3 Cheese & pepper biscuits – own recipe
- 53 3 Flapjacks – own recipe
- 54 Pot of fruit jam

SECTION D – JUNIOR CLASSES

Senior (age 7-10) and **Junior** (age under 7) **Hawtin Trophies** for most points in classes 55 to 58

- 55 3 decorated cup cakes
- 56 Hand drawn painting/drawing of wildlife scene
- 57(a) for Juniors under 7s a painted paper butterfly
- 57(b) for Seniors over 7 a painting/drawing of the life cycle of a butterfly – egg, caterpillar, chrysalis, adult.
